#### **Spring Creek Nature Area**

The City of Richardson dedicated the Portals into the Spring Creek Nature Area on November 16,



2019. Mayor Paul Voelker, city officials and special guests cut the ribbon to officially open the perimeter trails. Voelker talked about the opportunity to experience a peaceful environment in the middle of a very busy city. He talked about the 40 thousand trees that are lungs of the city and hearing the wind, animals and birds. (*Read More on Website*)



The husband and wife team, Brad and Diana Goldberg designed the portals from a special granite called Kenoran sage. Kenoran sage was quarried in southern Canada, processed in northern Minnesota during the winter of 2018-2019 and delivered by large truck/trailer rigs.

#### **Cardboard Box Recycling**

It's Friday - recycling day - and those Amazon boxes and other cardboard items are piling up. Be sure they get recycled by following City of Richardson



guidelines. The city prefers that cardboard boxes be placed inside blue bags, or larger boxes flat-packed and placed near your blue bags. Remember, the city will not

recycle wet or damp boxes, and it will instead get picked up as trash and placed in landfills. So, on rainy days, place your boxes inside the blue bags to ensure they get recycled.


